Fluent Families Series

What is it? Series of informational and interactive events and workshops for families, agencies and the ministries serving families and the community. Events can range from a 30 minute informational session tailored for the people you serve, to a full workshop that provides resources and continuing education to the community. All events include helpful examples and stories from our own clients, who range from infants and very young children to older people.

Who is it for? Any family or group affected by behavior, communication, or social interaction challenges. Often our clients are involved in foster parenting, adoption, or raising a child or grandchild with challenging behavior. Sometimes they have experienced difficulty in school, learning to eat or talk, or interact with others. Other times, our clients are adults struggling with the challenges of aging and communicating with those around them (such as caregivers supporting Alzheimer's).

Who provides the workshops and education? The provider is Dr. Camille, a Board Certified Behavior Analyst who has worked in the Colorado community since 2010. Dr. Camille Kolu has a Ph.D. in behavioral neuroscience and is a practicing behavior analyst. She is Board Certified and has experience with all age ranges and many populations. Her clients include families dealing with autism, trauma, foster care, adoption, developmental disabilities, brain injury, or caring for a loved one.

What can I expect from a training or workshop? A new agency working with Dr. Camille Kolu can select from several topics to decide which one fits best for the first training. Dr. Camille arrives at the location and asks questions to understand the attendees and their needs. She provides a brief training and information and then assembles resources to help the agency take the next step. Then, if needed, Dr. Camille can recommend and/or provide additional trainings and support based on the needs of the community.

What are some topics Dr. Camille explores? Each of these (and more) can be explored in a stand-alone meeting or can be integrated in a longer event, depending on how long your team has available:

INTRODUCTION TO BEHAVIORAL SERVICES (WHAT TO EXPECT FOR YOUR LOVED ONE WHO NEEDS BEHAVIOR SUPPORT); UNDERSTANDING CHALLENGING BEHAVIOR FOR CAREGIVERS; TURNING CHALLENGES INTO COMMUNICATION (FOR CAREGIVERS OR AGENCIES); FOSTERING BEHAVIORAL WELLNESS (FOR FOSTER OR ADOPTIVE FAMILIES); PLAYING AROUND (STRATEGIES FOR MANAGING ANXIETY THROUGH PLAY); NEW TO AUTISM OR EARLY INTERVENTION
